A 30day, 25-bed emergency shelter is available for women and children in crisis. This is a full-service shelter offering free food, housing, and clothing to victims. Also available on site are caseworkers, child caseworkers, support groups, parenting classes, and free legal consultation and transportation. The shelter has an extensive children's program, including caseworkers for children, parenting classes, and babysitting services.
